

PROJECT: ILLUSTRATOR PORTRAIT

Meets Florida Curriculum Criteria(s):01.0; 04.0; 06.0; 09.0

TASK: Trace a vector portrait of anyone using Illustrator.

EXAMPLES: Vector Portrait Examples

YOU WILL NEED TO:

- Do your practice. Feel comfortable with the pen tool. Do some tutorials.
- Using a photo of a celebrity or famous figure, use Adobe Illustrator to make a vector portrait of them
- ♦ Then, use the pen tool and trace it in up to five colors
- Create a final in Illustrator. Al file.

DESIGN SPECIFICS & TURNING IN YOUR WORK:

- ♦ Size is 8.5"w x 11" h.
- Work in up to five colors Maximum
- Save your original in Al file in your folder.
- ♦ Save a .PNG version this to the class folder marked _VECTOR_PORTRAIT

GRADING:

- 3 points for completing both portraits
- Credit for following specifics above
- Credit for level of effort and creativity involved
- Credit for meeting deadline. Watch website for due date.

OUTCOME:

Students create unique artwork for their portfolio, manipulate in cross platform software, and inspire new students to explore more about the artists or person represented and up their design practice and game in class.
